

What is Lifelong Learning ?



On October 30, Lifelong Learning presented Bats, Beasts and Broomsticks: A Baroque All-Hallows-Eve Concert. Baroque and Renaissance music of the season, by composers Bach, Telemann, Rameau, and friends, on period instruments. Learn about the European world 250-500 years ago through composers' music about monsters, witches, devils, cemeteries and more.


Lifelong Learning is one of the largest clubs in SCCL, with over eight hundred paid members. Members may attend weekly programs at The Lodge on Monday evenings from 7:00–8:00 p.m.

The programs feature speakers with expertise on a wide variety of topics such as history, health, science and government, as well as literature, art, performance, area museums, and other attractions.


Following a presentation of around forty-five minutes, the audience is encouraged to interact with each speaker by making comments or asking questions.

Most speakers are not residents of SCCL but are drawn from the surrounding colleges and universities and the greater Charlotte metropolitan area.
