

Using Zelle to pay Bocce fees

The Bocce Club now has the ability to accept payment for your dues and end of year party via **Zelle**. Zelle is a US based digital payment network and enables individual users to transfer funds to another users bank account. There is currently no fee or charge for the transaction.

This is not a requirement, checks will still be accepted as a payment option.

To use Zelle, you will need to set up an account on your bank's website which is a quick and easy process.

Once your account is set, you can then "Add a new recipient". Since the bocce club operates as a business vs a personal account, click the business box and in the business name space enter:

Bocce Ball Club

Next, enter the Bocce club's email address for our Zelle account

scbocceball@gmail.com

Follow the payment instructions in your bank's system to pay your bocce fees (each bank's instructions may be slightly different).

- Enter the dollar amount you are paying; you can pay for more than one person per Zelle transaction.
- In the comments box ensure that you add the full name(s) of the people you are paying for so that your registration is credited correctly.

We hope that you will take advantage of this payment option. Many clubs within Sun City accept payment via Zelle.
